Data Services Websites

- According to a 2009 OCLC report, datasets are beginning to be made available online for "collecting," but libraries still need to learn how to support discovery.¹
- "It is important to establish a Web presence ... one way to accomplish this is through the creation of a separate category of data resources and by posting research guides . . . and serve as a reminder to refer in-depth questions to the data librarian."

ACCOLEDS Members

- There are 26 DLI members in Western Canada
- ACCOLEDS members fall into 3 broad categories based on FTE students:
 - Large = 15,000+(7)
 - Medium = 6,000-15,000 (12)
 - Small = under 6,000 (7)
- Most large & medium sized institutions have graduate programs

Our Approach Was To:

- Visit each Library's website to locate Data Services
- Use an upper-level undergraduate student perspective
- Be descriptive not prescriptive
- Look for commonalities, differences, interesting features and overall usability

General Observations

- Only 60 % of ACCOLEDS libraries have a web 'presence': a portal, subject guide, or other website focused on Data Services.
- Approx. 25% have separate GIS and Data webpages
- LibGuides are used in several libraries
- Very few libraries utilized RSS feeds and/or blogs

Collections

- Greater proportion of prairie libraries have access to other Data/GIS collections beyond DLI (e.g., DMTI, ICPSR)
- Datasets are not listed in most libraries' online catalogues
- CD-ROM products were not mentioned on most websites

Tools

- Most Data websites include links to at least one webaccessible search & retrieval tool
- There's a wide range of tools used including:
 - Equinox
 - UT/DLS (CHASS)
 - NESSTAR
 - Abacus
 - LANDRU
- More prairie libraries had links for downloading software (e.g. Beyond 20/20)

License Terms

- Very few websites mention DLI license terms
- License terms on authentication screens were sometimes only generic though we suspect that more specific terms were hidden behind a firewall
- Some libraries also required users to explicitly accept the DLI license terms
- Very few libraries seem to use paper forms

Help

- Almost all websites identify the Data librarian
- Less than half of websites had links to help/ training materials

Putting Ideas Into Action

- The University of Lethbridge Data Services website has been extensively revised in order to:
 - Improve usability
 - Incorporate general "best practices" for library websites
 - Encourage interaction with users

Concepts/Approaches Used To Improve Website Usability

- Transform from a Mediated Service to Self-Serve
- Utilize "discovery" systems currently in use
- Integrate the discovery of datasets with other types of resources
- Highlight LOCAL datasets i.e., City of Lethbridge datasets
- Build a "Community of Practice" related to each type of Data
- Facilitate use by non-practitioners through the building of FAQ's & HELP tools based on community requests/contributions


